RAFFLES AND LOTTERIES

Depending on whether you are selling tickets for your raffle on the day or prior to this event, there are different requirements to be aware of.

LICENSES

If you fancy a wee tipple at a party please make sure that the venue for your event has a license. If you are unsure contact your local authority.

FOOD HYGIENE

If you are providing food at your event you need to make sure that everything is cooked/prepared safely.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

Nobody likes to feel unsafe at an event so please use your common sense to ensure no accidents can happen. Obviously if something goes wrong make sure you have a trained first aider to hand!

DATA PROTECTION

If you are gathering information on anyone who attends your event (through sponsorship forms/raffle envelopes etc.) it is better to ask them if it is ok for us to contact them in the future.

PRESS AND P.R.

Why not send a press release to your local newspaper and let them know all about your event? They may even come along to take photos! Social media is a great way to advertise for free!

How Your Fundraising Helps Cancer Support Scotland

Thank you once again for choosing to fundraise for Cancer Support Scotland. The money you raise allows us to provide emotional and practical support to anyone affected by cancer. This support comes in the form of:

- COMPLEMENTARY THERAPIES We offer a diverse range of therapies to anyone in need of relaxation in body and/or mind. These extend from Aromatherapy, Chiropody, Hypnotherapy, Massage, Reflexology and Reiki.
- TALKING THERAPY Our trained talking therapists (counsellors) will listen and talk people through their anxieties and fears. They are there to help anyone affected by cancer and offer a shoulder to lean on.
- SUPPORT GROUPS Our support groups are spread across Scotland and here
 to help anyone affected by cancer. Our groups meet on a regular basis and have
 created trusted relationships and safe environments to air their concerns. We
 have a group for young people aged 16-25 called conTAK which aims to
 produce a secure setting where patients can speak their mind amongst their
 peers.
- INFORMATION We provide information and support to anyone in need of it.
 We have an array of information leaflets and books ranging from cancer treatments, how to tell your family and how your employer should help you.
